Mobility Pay:

Soon you will be able to bank from your mobile phone with our banking App. Check your balance, make transfers and more. Why wait on line when you can bank at any moment at any time.

Courtesy Pay:

Courtesy Pay will allow us to cover your insufficient funds items on debit card purchases, point-of-sale (POS) transactions, ATM withdrawals, checks and ACH transactions.

EMV:

Your 1199 Federal Credit Union debit card will soon come equipped with computer chips and the technology used to authenticate chip-card transactions for added security.

Account Create:

Opening an account with us will be easier than ever as we will soon introduce to you a method that will allow you to open an account with is online. By submitting your information online, you can save yourself the hassle of faxing or mailing your application. We will receive your application and begin processing immediately.

ACH Origination:

Soon you will be able to transfer and receive funds from the credit union to and from any other financial institution.

Direct Deposit And Your Tax Refund: What A Pair!

Your federal and state income tax refunds can be deposited directly into your Savings or Checking Account at the credit union.



This process is:

Quick: Directly deposited tax refunds come weeks before checks in the mail.

Easy: Just check the Savings or Checking Account box, enter your credit union member number (not the last four digits of your social security number) and enter our routing number 226077862.

Convenient: You don't have to go to the credit union to make a deposit.

Safe: Your check won't get lost or stolen in the mail.

If your tax return is a joint return, your refund must be deposited into a joint account. Direct deposit must go through the ACH process since we do not support wire transactions.
